

Training is NECESSARY to prepare well...

In Ukraine, the humanitarian response is in full swing, with national staff organizing to deliver aid as quickly as possible while building capacity by bringing in extra staff. Time is of the essence to get operations fully up and running.

During our assessment, we have identified gaps in the preparation of humanitarian staff for working in an active warzone. Therefore, PMO has designed the Armed Conflict Awareness Training (ACAT). This is a one-day training that focuses on remaining as safe as possible while operating in a direct combat zone.

We will be giving this training in Lviv and soon elsewhere in Ukraine. This training will be indoors to minimize exposure in order to maintain a safe learning environment. Drills, videos, and case studies will keep the training active and give the participants the space to practice the skills that we would normally do outdoors. *

- **Armed conflict: Attack by air, small arms fire, shelling**
- **Concealment and protection: vehicles, nature, structures, protective gear and its limitations**
- **Driving & Travel in a hostile environment**
- **Communication**
- **IHL: Dealing with combatants, visibility, distinction and compliance**
- **Medical Emergency**
- **Mines and Explosives**
